BOARD ELECTION NEWS

There will be two open seats for the Board of Education election on April 8, 2025. The incumbents are Julie Hettinger and Jessica Lunsford. Those elected will serve three-year terms. The first day for candidates to file is Tuesday, December 10, 2024 at 8:00 a.m. The last day for candidates to file will be Tuesday, December 31, 2024 at 5:00 p.m.

A candidate must be a U.S. citizen, a resident taxpayer of the Adair County R-II School District, have resided in the state of Missouri for at least one year preceding the election, and be at least 24 years of age.

Candidates may be required to file a financial interest statement and must agree to obtain 16 hours of credit in school boardsmanship within 12 months of the election.

Per RSMo 115.306 **ALL** candidates are required to file Form 5120 *Candidate's Affidavit of Tax Payments and Bonding Requirements* with the Missouri Department of Revenue **PRIOR** to filing for office. Interested candidates can pick up a form

from the superintendent's office or access the form online at <https://dor.mo.gov/forms/5120.pdf>

Candidates may file in the Superintendent's office beginning on Tuesday, December 10 at 8:00 a.m. Candidates must supply the district with a completed, signed, and notarized copy of Form 5120 before they can file. Filing will continue during the district's regular business hours which are Tuesday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Filing will not occur on days that the school is closed due to inclement weather. The superintendent's office will be closed December 23-December 27 and therefore will not be accepting candidates filing on those dates. On December 31, the office will be open from 3:00-5:00 p.m. for filing purposes. Questions? Call the Superintendent's office at 323-5272 during regular business hours.
