HABIT OF THE MONTH

Our habit for February is Seek First to Understand, Then to Be Understood®. At school, we say that means to listen with our ears, eyes, and heart! Here are a couple of activities you can do at home to practice this habit!

1. **Mood Charades** - Write several different emotions (anger, sadness, happiness, disappointment, etc.) on small pieces of paper and put them in a box. Have each family member draw one of the papers from the box and act out the mood while the others try to guess what the emotion is. Point out that you can learn a lot about what others are trying to say by using your eyes to watch their faces and body movements.
2. **Listen Up!** - Role play the following forms of listening: *Ignore what the other person is saying, *Pretend to listen but don't really pay attention, *Listen only to select parts of what they say, *Listen with the intent to reply, *Interrupt with your own opinions. Then: Talk about why it is important to listen. How do you feel when someone listens to you? How do you feel when someone does not listen to you?

DISTRICT REPORT CARD AVAILABLE

State law (Section 160.522, RSMo) requires the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education to produce, at least annually, a school accountability report card for each public school district, each public school building, and each charter school in the state. The reports are designed to satisfy state and federal requirements for the disclosure of statistics about students, staff, finances, academic achievement, and other indicators. The information is compiled from data reported to the Department by local school districts.

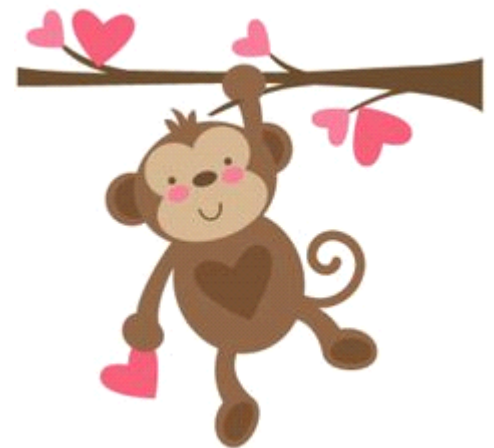

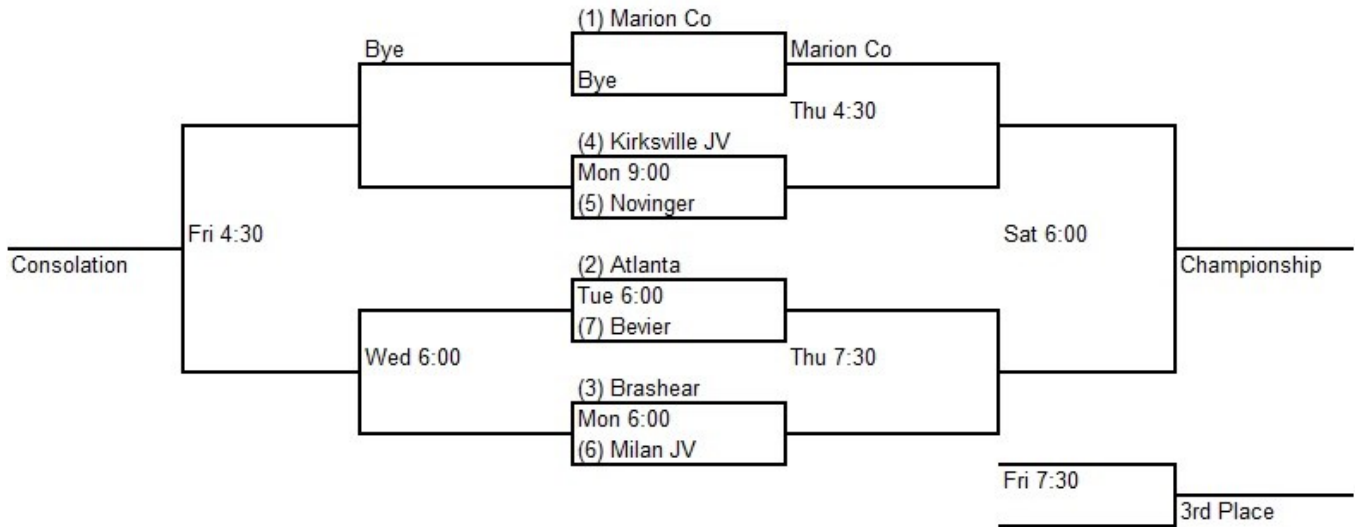
BRASHEAR TOURNAMENT

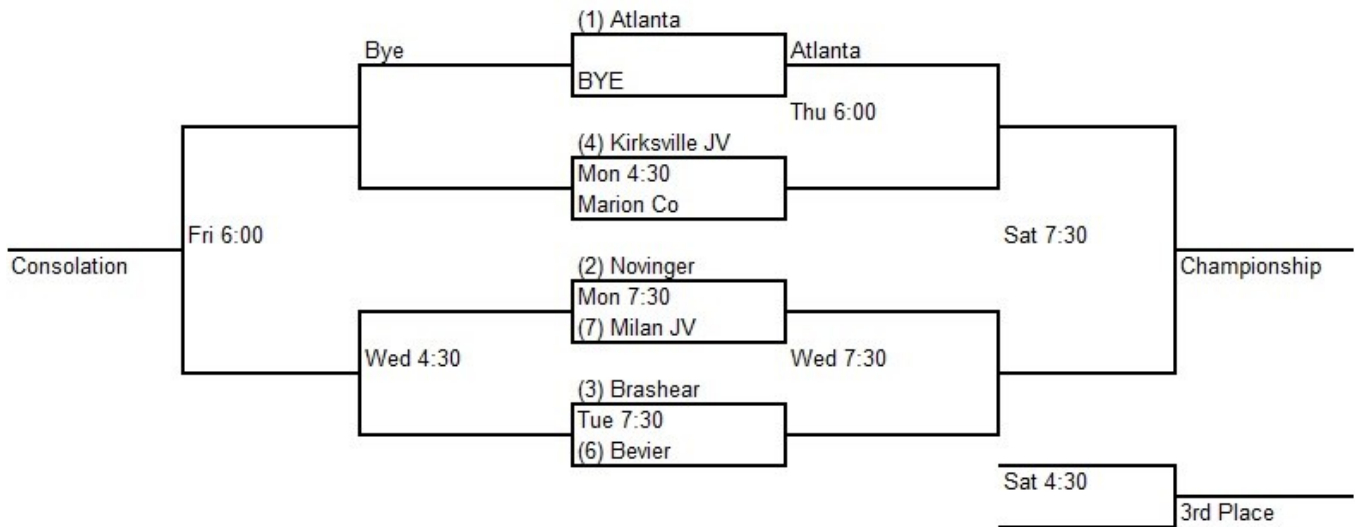
