The district will not hold an election since the number of candidates who have filed for the Board is equal to the number of positions available.

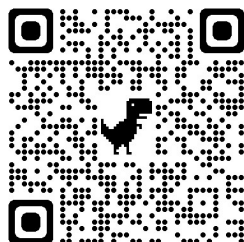
If you are not a registered voter, the last day to register to vote in the general municipal election is Wednesday, March 12, 2025.

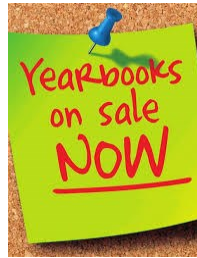

TIGER PRIDE

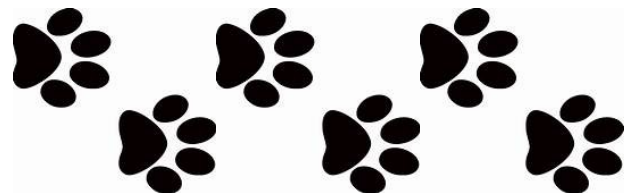
Gracie Baker was selected as our Kirksville Optimist Club Student of the Quarter for 1st Quarter.
