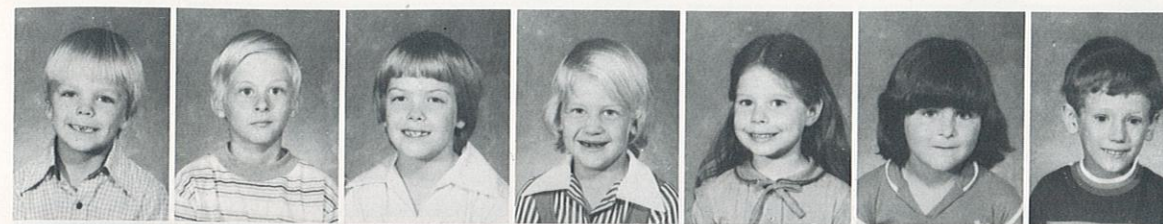
The Second Grade had a total of twenty kids this year.
