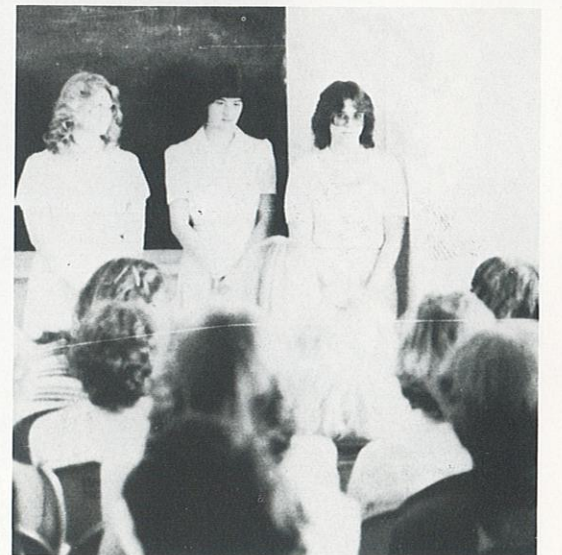


# FHA Takes A New Look

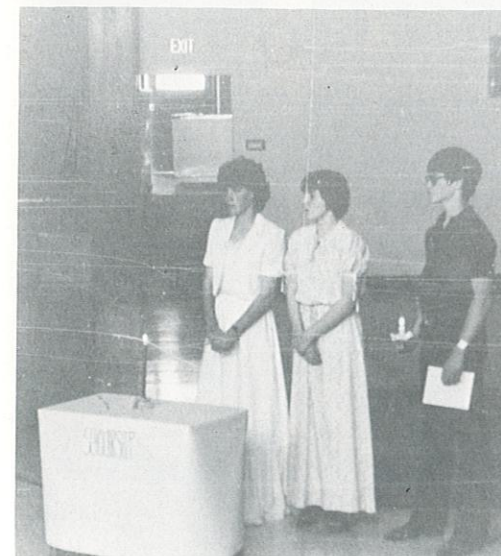
This year the Brashear National Honor Society was made up of 12 members. Some of the projects were making money by selling cinnamon rolls and hot chocolate and planting trees as a community service.

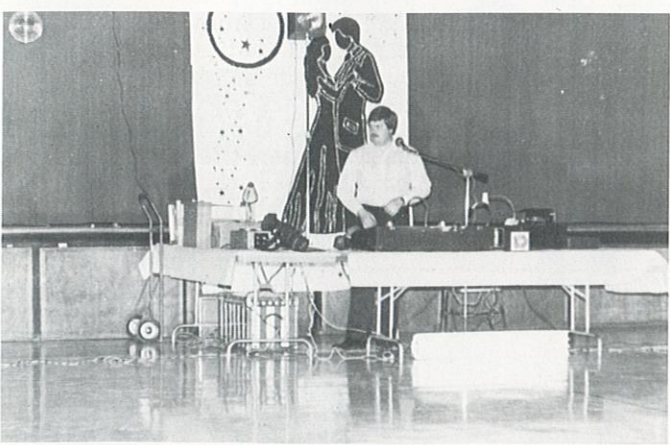
The Junior Class of 1981-82 presented the Junior-Senior Prom April 17, 1982, at Brashear High School.
