




Miss Gehrke retired this year after teaching for a total of 34 years. Twenty-two of those years have been at Brashear High School.


Mrs. Hunt retired in 1964, ending a teaching career of 23 years. She had spent 15 years of her career at Brashear High School.





On January 30, 1965 twenty school districts in the eastern third of Adair County voted to form a reorganized district. The area is now known as Adair County R II School District. The districts included in this area were Pleasant Hill #1, Wilmaths-ville #2, Olive Hill #19, Garden Grove #20, Oak Grove #21, Hazel Green #22, New Zion #39, Elliott #40, Normal Mound #41, Paultown #42, Pleasant Hill #43, Brashear #44, Oak Dale #45, Prairie Bird #66, Gibbs #67, Fairview #69, Gopher Hill #68, Star #70, Wilson #71, and Banner #72.

The valuation of the RII district is \$3,100,705.00 with an enumeration of 425. During the 1964-1965 school year the following rural schools were in operation: Wilmathsville, Garden Grove, Hazel Green, Star and Gibbs.


