



RENE D. HUNT

Rene D. Hunt retired from a forty-year teaching career at the close of the 1967-68 school year after twenty-two years at Brashear. In September, 1946 he began serving the Brashear School District #44 and continued serving when the district became part of the Adair County RII Reorganized District.

Rene D. was born at Grant, Iowa, on March 21, 1903, to George S. and Laura Duree Hunt. He has an older sister, Sadie, and a younger brother, Bruce, both of Kirksville. The family lived for a few years in North Dakota then moved to Holt County in northwest Missouri.

Rene was a good athlete. He went out for football his first year and played in the first football game he ever saw. He lettered in football, basketball, and track all three years he attended Kirksville High School.

After graduating from high school in May, 1922, Mr. Hunt entered the Kirksville State Teachers College in June. He received his B.S. in Education Degree in 1922, his Masters Degree in 1948, and was prominent in athletics for five quarters.

On August 3, 1923, he married his high school sweetheart, Ora Waddill of Brashear. A daughter, Jeanne, was born on May 19, 1924.

Through the years 1923-46, energetic Hunt was employed in many different places in various capacities. Some of his appointments were coaching, teaching math and science, and being superintendent at Humphreys, Knox City, Brashear, Bible Grove, Dalton, Queen City and Kinderhook, Ill.; salesman in Hannibal; a war plant employee at Louisiana; and a businessman in Kirksville.

Since 1946 he has devoted untold time and effort to the progress and betterment of the Brashear Schools. The valuation of the district has increased through annexation and reorganization from \$163,000 to over \$3,000,000. The tax levy has only increased from \$2.55 to \$3 during this time and a new high school building has been constructed. There are currently five buildings in use that make up the housing for grades K through 12.

The total enrollment has gone from 170 to 330. The faculty has increased from 8 to 22 and the number of units offered in the high school has increased from 18 1/4 to 44. Three buses were operating in 1946 while presently seven are covering the district.

Mr. Hunt is also city clerk and is active in the Lions Club and church work.

Superintendent Hunt was never satisfied with the past accomplishments, but always worked for better educational opportunities for the students of the school district.


JUNIOR-SENIOR BANQUET AND PROM


