Annual financial awards to support continued education will be provided to one selected graduating senior from Adair County R-2 High School.

Financial Awards will be in the amount of \$250 for each recipient.

Selection Criteria

- Student Applicant's academic record requirement: 2.5 grade point average
- Student Applicant is planning continued education at technical school, community college, or 4-year university
- Student Applicant exhibits core values (honesty, integrity, good citizenship);
 demonstrates leadership/involvement in community and school activities
- Student Applicant's family must be current members of Adair-Schuyler County Farm bureau
- Applicant will complete application form and provide a short personal essay, sharing information regarding family background, education & career plan, and leisure interests
- Applicant will provide the names and contact information of two references who can support the application, should the selection committee wish to contact listed reference
- Applicant must provide higher education enrollment verification to the County office before the Award will be given

Selection Process

Applications must be received by the secretary of the Adair-Schuyler County Farm Bureau office by April 1st. Application will be reviewed by a financial award committee comprised of Adair-Schuyler County Farm Bureau Board members. The selection of a recipient and alternate from Schuyler County High School will be determined each year.
