To best communicate with your school, I wanted to share some information in regards to how Adair County R-II School is moving forward with Varsity Basketball contests at our school. Below you will find our guidelines and changes that have been made to our Attendance and our Concessions. Please take note of various signs and reminders displayed around the building.

Attendance:

- Masks are REQUIRED per the Adair County Health Department mask mandate.
- At this time, we are not limiting the amount of individuals from either school to attend that specific contest. Once your team is done playing, we ask that you exit the gym to make room for the fans of the next teams.
- We do encourage you to social distance and we are providing hand sanitizing stations leading to the gymnasium and cafeteria.
- Anyone feeling ill or experiencing symptoms should NOT attend and are encouraged to view the games via livestream.
- Please do not arrive more than 15 minutes prior to each game.
- There will be a table for a scorekeeper on the stage. Any student or person recording the games should sit in the bleachers, not on the stage.

Concessions:

- At this time, we are only serving pre-packaged items e.g. bottled water and soda, Lunchables, Uncrustables®, chips, beef jerky, protein bars, candy, etc.
- There will be a hospitality room available for administrators, coaches, and bus drivers.

Livestream:

- We will be live-streaming all of our contests online.
- To access the livestream, fans can go to our school website and the link for our contest will be at the top of the site. <http://brashear.k12.mo.us>

Seating:

- The top team in the bracket is considered the HOME team while the bottom team on the bracket is the VISITING team.
- The HOME team will sit on the North (far) end of the bleachers. Spectators should be seated with immediate family members and each group should be six feet apart.
- The VISITING team will sit on the South end of the bleachers. Spectators should be seated with immediate family members and each group should be six feet apart.

Brashear fans will always sit on the north end of the bleachers regardless of bracket placement.

After Each Game:

- At the end of each contest, all spectators will be asked to leave the gym while areas are disinfected.
- Spectators will be asked to wait outside for their athlete following the game.
