NO TAX INCREASE BOND ISSUE

The Adair County R-II School District Board of Education has voted to place a \$1,800,000 General Obligation Bond Issue on the ballot for the April 4, 2023 election. The proceeds from these bonds are to be used for the purpose of providing funds for the site development, construction, equipping, and furnishing of a new bus barn; to complete improvements at the sports complex; upgrade district technology; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District. We are pleased to be able to present this general obligation bond issue as one that does not require any increase in the debt service levy above the current \$.6511 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.
