GET THE LEAD OUT

In order to be compliant with the Missouri Law known as "Get the Lead Out of School Drinking Water Act," our district conducted sampling and testing of all potential drinking water sources in the school on December 5th, 2023. A letter from Superintendent Josh Brummit and the results of the water testing have been sent to parent email addresses on file in our student information system. The district has also posted the results on our website, http://brashear.k12.mo.us/dept/super/AdairR2PB.pdf.

The district has spent over \$41,000 to date on renovations to our water supply lines and outlets. While we have hand washing sinks and showers that are out of compliance, we will continue to test and remediate as necessary to meet the new standards.

BRASHEAR TOURNAMENT


