

DISTRICT RECEIVES DONATION

On December 12, the district received a \$25,000 donation from Jane Story to establish the Thomas J. Story Memorial Scholarship. Tom grew up near Willmathsville, MO. He attended all 12 years at Brashear (Adair County R-II) School and graduated with the Class of 1962. He was a lifelong farmer raising hogs and cattle. For several years Tom was a substitute mail carrier for the Brashear Post Office and later Hurdland Post Office. He also worked for the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) during the winters removing snow. Tom served on the Adair County R-II (Brashear) School Board for nine years, six as president. He thoroughly enjoyed serving and was very interested in all aspects of the school. Tom also served as an MFA Oil Delegate. He spent 12+ years playing slow-pitch softball with the Brashear team.

Mrs. Story will be working with guidance counselor Ellie Hazen to establish the criteria for this annual scholarship. Once established, seniors will be able to submit an application for the 2024 scholarship.

Tom was always willing to help his neighbors and friends. This generous gift will help our own aspiring young adults pursue higher education and become role models, like Tom, in their communities.
